With representatives from both governments and corporations, it will focus on the main drivers of corporate demand for cost-competitive renewable energy, its potential, and the enabling frameworks needed to support various forms of corporate sourcing of renewables. As contribution to the Clean Energy Ministerial (CEM) Corporate Sourcing of Renewables Campaign, IRENA will also launch the work on REmade Index. The event is organised by IRENA in partnership with CEM, RE100 and the World Business Council for Sustainable Development.

» Realising Renewable Energy Potential in Africa through NDCs Implementation

Focused on concrete experiences, this high level event will convene government representatives, climate finance institutes, development cooperation partners and civil society and provide an opportunity to discuss how African countries can reap the potential of renewable energy through Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) implementation, while advancing their national development priorities. The side-event will highlight the key features of tools and climate finance resources to support NDC implementation. The event will further focus on strengthening of partnerships and different roles and responsibilities in moving forward with an inclusive implementation of NDCs.
