Ms. Gauri Singh Deputy Director-General, IRENA

Ms. Gauri Singh is a career bureaucrat with an experience of over thirty years in policy formulation, implementation and policy advocacy in the field of renewable energy, sustainable development and livelihoods. She has worked at the federal level in the

Government of India and in Madhya Pradesh. At the federal level, particularly in the field of new and renewable energy, she has vast experience of policy formulation, coordination, and international cooperation. Policy initiatives led by her include, the policy framework of National Solar Mission of India 2010, to build solar power capacities in India. More recently, she steered the rural development sector, in Madhya Pradesh. Dr. Atiur Rahman is an honorary Professor of Development Studies and Bangabandhu Chair Professor at the University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. From 2009 to 2016, Dr. Rahman was the tenth Governor of the Central Bank of Bangladesh where he

supported a pro-poor, inclusive and sustainable development model through his flagship initiatives of financial inclusion and environmentally benign financial services including mobile and agent banking innovations. He is currently serving as a Special Adviser to Social Innovation Japan (SIJ) and has previously served as a member of the Advisory Board of UNEP's "Inquiry on Designing Global Sustainable Finance". Dr. Rahman holds a Ph.D. in Economics from the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), University of London.

Ms. Habiba Ali is the Founder, Managing Director and CEO of Sosai Renewable Energies, a company that empowers Nigeria's local business and communities with affordable renewable energy solutions including solar dryers, rooftop solar panels and micro-grids for communities.
