




- Transboundary pollution problem!

- Additional harmful pollution travelling into the EU from five neighbouring Western Balkan countries
- Most impacted EU neighbouring countries, but far away too













## Commitments under Energy Community Treaty



#### **Energy Community Treaty**

- Directive 2001/80/EC on the limitation of emissions of certain pollutants into the air from large combustion plants (LCPD, for existing plants) and
- Directive 2010/75/EU on industrial emissions (IED, for new plants)

#### Climate related: recommendations

- General Policy Guidelines on the 2030 targets
- Recommendation on preparing for the implementation of Regulation (EU) No 525/2013 on a mechanism for monitoring and reporting greenhouse gas emissions
- Recommendation on preparing for the development of integrated national energy and climate plans by the Gontracting Parties of the Energy Gommunity


#### 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

- · to ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy and
- to ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns

"rationalize inefficient fossil fuel subsidies that encourage wasteful consumption by removing market distortions, in accordance with national circumstances, including by restructuring taxation and phasing out those harmful subsidies, where they exist, to reflect their environmental impacts, taking fully into account the specific needs and conditions of developing countries and minimizing the possible adverse impacts on their development in a manner that protects the poor and the affected communities".

#### Paris Agreement


- to review their existing energy policies,

- redirect funds to achieve the Agreement's abatement goals












## Coal in electricity production EnC 2017












## Direct subsidies in EUR/MWh




#### Direct subsidy per 1 MWh produced in EUR, in average 2015-2017



# Direct coal subsidies vs RES incentives in the end users prices [2017]




Paid subsidies for RES and coal in the end users prices in 2017




## Estimation of full production costs in coal TPPs






## Costs of production in state owned utilities






## Estimated full costs of production vs retail price (energy and supplementary
