IRENA's "Long-term Energy Scenarios Network" (LTES Network) provides a platform for national and regional energy scenario practitioners to share experience and good practices in using and developing scenarios. As of mid-2021, the network gathers 25 country members and 10 technical partners and has hosted over [30 events](#). In its first year, the LTES Network organised a [1st webinar series](#) that featured its members and technical partners. Following the series' success, the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of webinars will feature new members and partners who have joined since 2020.
